- ► You will worship Him in spirit and in truth John 4:24

- If you know God you will serve Him better Daniel 11:32
- Fulfilment John 10:10
- Tossed about from doctrine to doctrine Ephesians 4:13-14
- If you don't know who God is you serve anything that looks good to you

What is a "god"?

- A god means that from which we are to expect all good and to which we are to take refuge in all distress, so that to have a God is nothing else than to trust and believe Him from the [whole] heart; - MARTIN LUTHER
- A god is synonymous to an idol
- "An idol is anything which is more fundamental than God to your happiness, meaning in life, or identity."

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DON'T SERVE GOD ALONE?

- Physical Death
- Spiritual Death You take the form of what you worship
 - -Psalm 115:1-5 , 135:15-18
 - -2 Corinthians 3:18
- Living in Sin. Idolatry is the source of all sin
- Disordered love
- Idolatry begins in the mind Romans 1
- You can't serve two masters, you will eventually hate and despise God-
 - -Matthew 6:24

WHAT DOES SERVING GOD ALONE LOOK LIKE?

- Matthew 4:10, "You shall worship the Lord your God and Him only shall you serve."
- Constantly evaluate your life with the help of the Holy Spirit and the Word of God – 2 Corinthians 10:5
- Put on the full armour of God Ephesians 6
