Who is God? - His Nature

- God is **spirit**, by nature intangible (John 4:24).
- God is triune,—God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit (Matthew 3:16-17).
- God is **infinite** (1 Timothy 1:17)
- God is incomparable (2 Samuel 7:22),
- God is **unchanging** (Malachi 3:6)
- God is everywhere (Psalm 139:7-12),
- God is all knowing (Psalm 147:5; Isaiah 40:28),
- God is all powerful and has all authority (Ephesians 1; Revelation 19:6).

Who is God? - His Character

- God is just (Acts 17:31),
- God is **loving** (Ephesians 2:4-5),
- God is truthful (John 14:6),
- God is **holy** (1 John 1:5).
- God is compassionate (2 Corinthians 1:3),
- God is merciful (Romans 9:15),
- God is gracious (Romans 5:17)
- God is forgiving (Psalm 103:10-12)

Who is God? - His Work

- God is the creator of the world (Genesis 1:1; Isaiah 42:5);
- God is actively sustains the world (Colossians 1:17);
- God is executing His eternal plan (Ephesians 1:11) which involves the redemption of man from the curse of sin and death (Galatians 3:13-14);
- God is drawing people to Christ (John 6:44);
- God is disciplining His children (Hebrews 12:6); and
- God will judge the world (Revelation 20:11-15).

²⁹ For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. ³⁰ And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified.

Sonship

J. I. Packer in his famous book Knowing God,

"find out how much he makes of the thought of being God's child, and having God as his Father. If this is not the thought that prompts and controls his worship and prayers and his whole outlook on life, it means that he does not understand Christianity very well at all."

What does this mean???

• God's purpose in the salvation of his people is invincible—it cannot fail—because it is based first not on our choosing God but on God's choosing us. So rest assured

Your salvation did not begin with your choice to believe in Christ—a choice which was real and necessary. Your salvation began before the creation of the universe when God planned the history of redemption, ordained the death and the resurrection of his Son, and chose you to be his own through Christ.

God loves us

God's plan for redemption was designed even before the fall.
