MR. CHAMBERLAIN DECLARES "IT IS PEACE FOR OUR TIME"

5,000 British Troops Will Be Sent To Sudetenland PRAGUE'S DAY OF SORROW

TO a frenzied welcome from tens of thousands of Londoners, Mr. Neville Chamberlain came home last night and announced to all the world: "I believe it is peace for our time."

GERMANS WILL MARCH AT NOON

ORDERS were given yesterday by General Brauchitsch, Chief of Staff for the German Army, to begin the march into Czechoslovakia at noon today (reports the British United Press).

"Our forces step into the liberated region," he said, "with the proud joy of being the bearers of German discipline and order."

The first Sudeten zone to be occupied will be the area north of Passau and Linz, in Upper Austria.

The Czech Government last night ordered evacuation to move immediately. It will be continued over the south-end.

The Premier had two agreements in his pockets:
1.—The Munich Four-Power Pact for the transfer of Sudetenland from Czechoslovakia to Germany; and
2.—An Anglo-German declaration of the "desire of our two peoples never to go to war with one another again."

Mr. Chamberlain's welcome in Downing Street was over-whelming. Women in tears cried: "Thank you, thank you." Police strove in vain to hold back the throng.

"The Second Time"

From a first-floor window of No. 18 the Prime Minister spoke to the crowd.

"My good friends," he said, "This is the second time in our history that a statesman has come back from Germany to Downing Street with peace with honour. [The first was in 1935, when Chamberlain returned from the Congress of Berlin.] I believe it is peace for our time."

Nearly 5,000 British troops will leave during the next few days for the policing of Sudetenland.

They will be battalions of the Coldstream Guards, Grenadier Guards, Scots Guards and Welsh Guards, together with two battalions of line regiments. One of these will be the Gordon Highlanders; the other had not been decided last night.

The men will travel by way of Brussels and Germany, and last night the War Office and Foreign Office were busy completing the arrangements for their transport.

The first draft of men are expected to travel to-morrow and the remainder on Monday and Tuesday.

One of the points still to be fixed is the uniform in which the men will travel.

Cabinet Meeting

A short meeting of the Cabinet was held last night, at which Mr. Chamberlain gave a brief report of the Munich negotiations.

No arrangements have been made for a further Cabinet meeting, and it is expected that the Premier will spend a quiet week-end in the country.

Parliament meets again on Monday, when it is expected the Munich agreement will be debated. Mr. Attlee, Labour's leader, and Mr. Greenwood, Deputy Leader, have cancelled their week-end meetings so as to remain in close touch with the situation.

Before the House assembles, the National Council of Labour, the Executive of the Parliamentary Labour Party, and Labour M.P.s will meet.

The Prime Minister's homecoming was one long triumphal procession.

At Heston there were 15,000 people to welcome him. And there were cries of "well done" when Mr. Chamberlain passed from his pocket the Anglo-German agreement and said to the crowd: "Here is a paper which bears the names of Neville Chamberlain and Adolf Hitler."

The Premier held the document, typewritten on foolscap paper, high above his head for the crowd to see. Beneath the typewritten words were the names "Neville Chamberlain" and "Adolf Hitler."

"I want to say," Mr. Chamberlain stated, "that the settlement of the Czechoslovak problem is only a prelude to a larger settlement in which all Europe may find peace."

"Superior Force"

From Heston the Prime Minister drove through miles of cheering streets to Buckingham Palace. Here again his reception was overwhelming. Tremendous crowds shouted: "We want Chamberlain!" and sang "For he's a jolly good fellow."

The crescendo of cheering reached its climax as first the King and Queen and then Mr. and Mrs. Chamberlain stepped out on to the Goodrich balcony.

Czechs Cry "We Want to Fight"

And so to Downing Street—and more frenzied applause. London's West End last night was filled with jubilation crowds.

Trade was at times almost at a standstill.

In contrast to all this rejoicing, Prague yesterday was a city of sorrow. Tens of thousands of people paraded the streets shouting: "We want the whole Republic! We want to fight!"

The city authorities, fearful lest Germany might seize this pretext for an invasion, ordered a "black-out" to get the crowds off the streets.

General Sirrov, the Czech Premier, broadcast a message to the nation in which he said: "We have accepted unheard-of sacrifices. . . . Superior force has compelled us to accept. . . . But the nation will be stronger and more united."

What They Will Lose

It is now clear that the Czechs, under the terms of the agreement, will lose:

- The radium mines of Joachimsthal;
- Large tracts of timberland coal and lead deposits;
- Rich soils of timber;
- Ironworks, glassworks and breweries;
- The famous vine of Kladsko, Mariesbad and Franzensbad.

They will not, however, lose the famous Pilsen brewery or the great Kladsko munition works.

Examination of the detailed plan (given in full on Page 7) shows great modifications by Hitler of the demands made in his Godesberg ultimatum.

Many questions which Hitler then said would be decided by Germany "unilaterally," are now to be referred to the International Commission, which held its first meeting in Berlin yesterday.

Also, Hitler will now guarantee the new Czechoslovakia if a minority agreement is reached with Poland and Hungary, and provision is made for exchange of population.

Poles Rush Ultimatum

WARSAW, Friday night.
WITHIN 24 hours of one threat of an immediate war on the Czechs being averted, Poland to-night handed a new ultimatum to Prague.

Imposing a 24-hour time limit, the ultimatum insisted on an immediate answer to the demand that all Czech territory inhabited by Poles shall be evacuated at once.

A Warsaw Foreign Office spokesman announced that the Note was reached Prague by air at 11 o'clock to-night. An official communication signed by the Czechoslovakian answer to the Polish Note, sent last Tuesday, contained a detailed plan of frontier adjustments in Teschen, Silesia, and the Polish Corridor.

The Polish Government had, therefore, sent another Note requesting a "clear and precise" answer and the cessation of the territory.

The answer to the Note is expected by noon to-morrow.

The emergency with the sending of the ultimatum, the threat was broadcast from all Polish radio stations, and the Government.

"will resort to measures which may have the gravest consequences." Suggestions were made that Polish troops would enter the Teschen district of Czechoslovakia to-morrow at the same time that the Germans occupied the area ceded to them.

The official version, however, declared that the hour is approaching when Polish troops will first be sent to Czechoslovakia with their dead weapons.

Reports were circulated in Warsaw to-day of alleged "incidents" in the Czech border.

An urgent meeting was called, attended by General Smigly-Rydz, Chief Marshal of Poland, President Mojski, the Premier, vice-Premier and Foreign Minister.

Colonel Beck, the Foreign Minister, then declared in turn the Ambassador of Germany, Prague, Italy, Britain, Russia and the United States, and the Hungarian Minister.

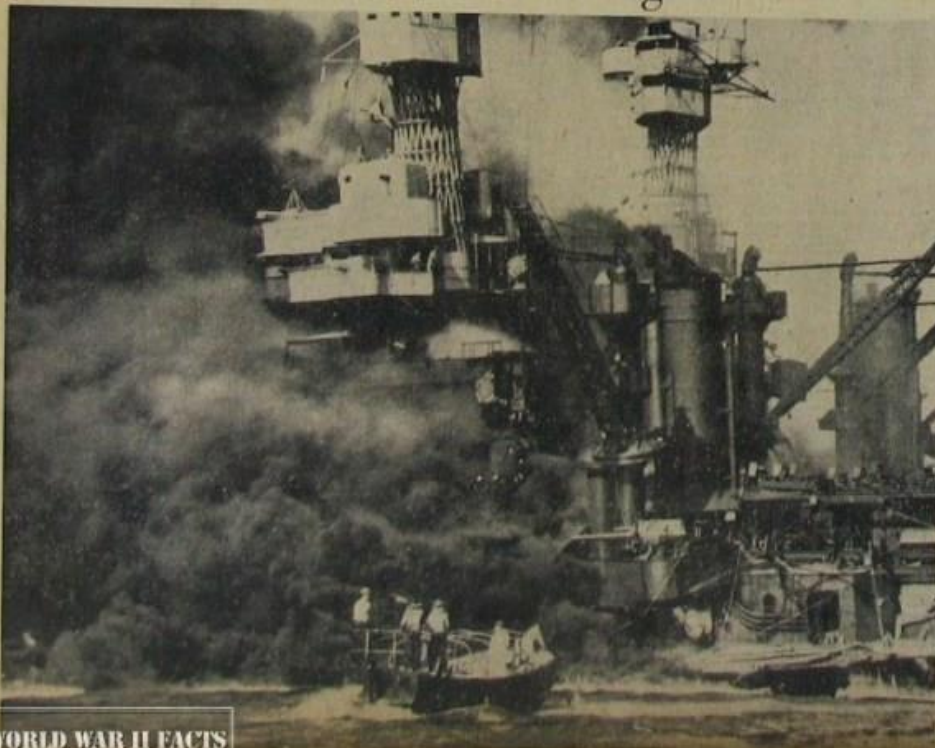

AMERICAN POWER OVERWHELMS FOE

Washington, Aug. 14.—President Truman announced at 7 p. m. (Youngstown time) Japanese acceptance of surrender terms.

They will be accepted by General Douglas MacArthur when arrangements can be completed.

Mr. Truman read the formal message relayed from Emperor Hirohito through the Swiss government in which the Japanese ruler pledged the surrender on the terms laid down by the Big Three conference at Potsdam.

President Truman made this statement:

"I have received this afternoon a message from the Japanese government in reply to the message forwarded to that government by the Secretary of State on August 11.

No Qualifications

"I deem this reply a full acceptance of the Potsdam declaration which specifies the unconditional surrender of Japan.

"In this reply there is no qualification.

"Arrangements are now being made for the formal signing of surrender terms at the earliest possible moment.

"General Douglas MacArthur has been appointed the supreme Allied commander to receive the Japanese surrender.

"Great Britain, Russia and China will be represented

This message expressed Hirohito's "extreme concern" at the "calamity caused by the United States."

White House aids emphasized that on the basis of previously laid plans V-J Day could not come until the latter part of the week. They laid heavy stress on the fact that Japan actually will not have surrendered until responsible Japanese leaders have signed on the dotted line.

There was good reason to believe that had the acceptance not come through today the atomic bomb campaign would have been resumed and one hint of this came in a report from Guam that Superfortresses were again thundering northward against enemy industrial targets. The B-29s were used to make the bomb attacks and had been out of action since Saturday.

And, this was not all that was in store for the enemy. President Truman, it was reported by military authorities, had counted on the use of newly developed weapons in America's secret arsenal to shock and knock Japan out of the fighting at an early date.

The Potsdam demand for unconditional surrender would reduce Japan to her four main islands. The later Allied note would allow Emperor Hirohito to remain as a monarch committed to promulgate any edicts which the victorious Allies handed to him.

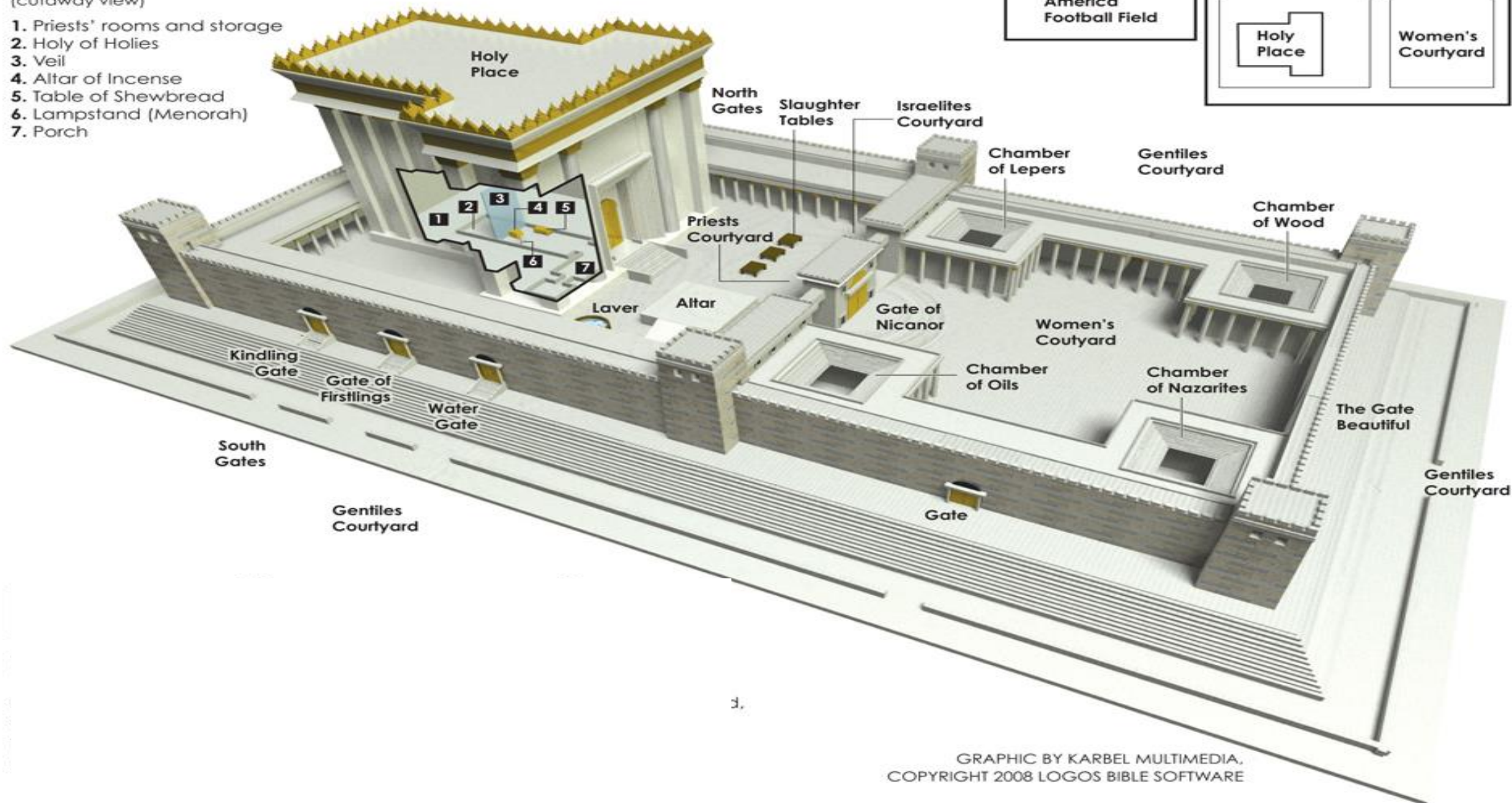
