2. Keep you from knowing Christ
3. Keep you from serving effectively

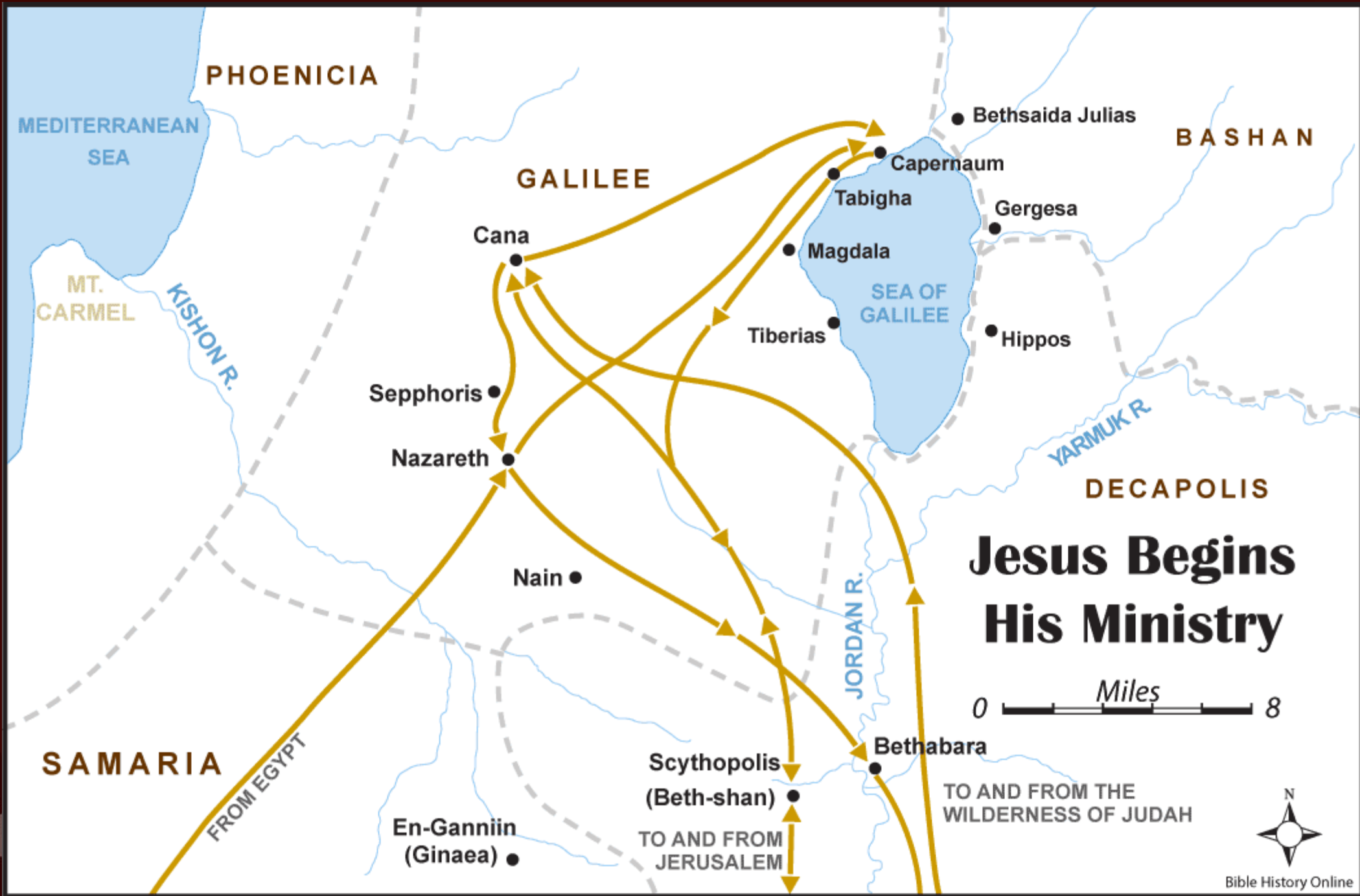
